WHAT YOU WILL DO

As an intern, you will usually spend one hour in the morning learning employability and life skills before experiencing a typical workplace day, working for four hours. A catch-up session is included at the end of the day.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- You must have an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP)*.
- You must be aged between 18 and 24 years.
- You must have the desire to achieve full-time employment**.
- You must be a resident of Hull/East Riding of Yorkshire catchment area
- Applicants will be required to go through an interview process to be offered a place on this course.
- Enrolment on the course will be subject to relevant vetting clearance undertaken by Humberside Police.

*If you do not have an EHCP at the time of the interview, you will need to be in receipt of one by enrolment to be admitted onto the course.

**At least 16 hours per week.



TIME COMMITMENT

The programme lasts one academic year. You would be on placement Monday to Friday, completing three placement rotations to explore a variety of career paths.

YOUR FUTURE

At the end of the programme, interns will be provided with support from your tutor and Bishop Burton College's careers team to help you find sustained paid employment.
