$$\begin{cases} 2x_1 + x_2 = 7 \\ x_1 + x_2 - 3x_3 = -10 \\ 6x_2 - 2x_3 + x_4 = 7 \\ 2x_3 - 3x_4 = 13 \end{cases}$$

POA Learning offer Maths and English Functional Skills qualifications at levels 1 and 2 on a distance learning basis, meaning that you can complete the courses in your own time and fit them around work and life commitments. Level 2 Functional Skills is equivalent to grades A – C GCSE. There is a charge of £25 per course and anyone can sign up for them.
