The Fundamentals of Care Programme aims to increase awareness, knowledge and some competency around management of specific conditions and support tasks for those supporting individuals with a Learning Disability within our County.

If you support an individual who has a learning disability you can have access to this programme subject to managerial authorisation and the below pre-requisites.

Before undertaking this programme, you will need to have:

- Support from your manager
- Completed the Care Certificate or equivalent induction standards
- Have at least one year's experience of working within the health and social care sector
- Be working towards completing Oliver McGowan Tier 2 and RESTORE2 mini



Modules include:

Personalised Care Approach;

- PBS
- Person centred communication
- Friendships, relationships, sex and sexuality
- Advance Care planning and Bereavement support

Physical Health Care;

- Nutrition & Hydration
- Continence care including constipation
- Recognising and responding to the deteriorating and unwell person
- Epilepsy
- Oral Hygiene

Emotional Support;

- Trauma informed care
- Attachments and relationships
- Promoting mental health and well-being
