Let's Talk Suicide

This is 2 half day awareness training session for people in public facing roles from the Public and Voluntary Community Sector Organisations. Attendance on both sessions is required.

Course content: Improve knowledge and understanding of suicide, Explore the myths and facts surrounding suicide, Develop an understanding of suicide and stigma, Recognise the wider impact of suicide, Recognise risk factors and warning signs for suicide, Identify effective risk assessing skills, Build skill and confidence in responding to and supporting someone in suicidal crisis, Recognise the importance of recovery and support and Identify appropriate services to signpost to.
