



Oliver McGowan Mandatory Training in Learning Disability & Autism – additional dates

We're delighted to be continuing Oliver's training for a little longer and pleased to be able to offer additional Tier 1 and Tier 2 training dates.

Tier 1 training

Tier 1 entails two hours of online activity, including viewing an information film and attending a 30-minute live webinar, hosted via Zoom.

It is relevant to all staff working in any sector who may occasionally interact with autistic people or people with a learning disability, but who do not have responsibility for providing direct care or making decisions about care or support.

If you have **completed the Tier 1 e-learning module**, but not yet attended the webinar, please book on to gain your full Tier 1 certificate.

People are very welcome to attend both tiers, but in general, clinical staff (doctors, nurses, healthcare assistants, allied health professionals, for example) should attend Tier 2. Non-clinical staff (administrative, facilities or estates management colleagues, for example) should attend Tier 1.

If you have completed the tier relevant to your role during the trial or evaluation period, **you will not need to repeat it** when it becomes mandatory, until the renewal cycle.

Tier 2 training

Tier 2 is a whole-day event (9.30am to 4.30pm) for which you can book a physical or virtual place. The in-person sessions are being held in a number of Gloucestershire venues – details below.

The training is co-delivered by an Expert by Experience, a family carer and a professional person working within a learning disability service. It is relevant to health and social care staff and others with responsibility for providing care and support for autistic people or people with a learning disability, but who would seek support from others for complex management or complex decision making.

Please note, we are no longer delivering hybrid (virtual/in-person mixed) sessions.
