Supporting the Emotional Needs of People with **Learning Disabilities - Team Booking**

The booking is set up where a staff team books on together – ie, there are four slots per training session which means 4 staff groups can book into one training session. We allow up to 6

staff members per staff group and encourage staff teams to come together rather than by themselves because there will be time for group work in breakout rooms where a staff team will discuss together a particular person they support.

Can you spare 2 hours to complete this excellent training? E-learning followed by a 30 minute

webinar, which are delivered by an expert by experience.

The E-learning can be accessed on Learnpro community, Show All E-learning, then select Other category.

So long as they have completed the tier relevant to their role, those who have completed the training during the trial or evaluation period will not need to repeat it when it becomes mandatory, until the renewal cycle.


