### **The role:**

For the first twelve months of this post, your focus will be on the delivery of a project to improve access to personalised care planning in the community for people with a diagnosis of cancer. Thereafter, you will undertake a range of project work relating to palliative and end of life care in Cheshire;

- Lead on the scoping, planning, delivery and evaluation of projects, including the identification of key milestones, deliverables, and benefits.
- Build effective co-ordination and collaboration with stakeholders and with commissioning leads, clinicians and partners to effect change at scale and pace to deliver seamless, high quality and innovative care.
- Support collaborative working across different organisations, including primary care, community care, hospital trusts, third sector organisations and other agencies.
- Act as responsible Project Lead and report progress regularly.
- Develop strategies and action plans that will impact across all providers of end of life and palliative care.
- Evaluate intelligence and feedback to recommend a range of evidence based service redesign projects/programme that support strategic and operational clinical commissioning objectives and that seek to reduce health inequalities and improve health outcomes of the local population
