ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Qualification Entry: Full and relevant Level 3 Early Years/Childcare qualification or equivalent as published by the DfE.

If you do not already hold Early Years Educator Status from your Level 3 qualification, we offer the Early Years (with Early Years Educator) pathway which will give you Licence to Practice and is classified as a "full and relevant" qualification by the Department for Education (UCAS code: X120*). In addition to the core modules, you will complete a Reflective Professional Practice Record (RPPR).

Experience: Relevant two-year experience (exceptions to be presented at APEL)

Employment: A minimum of 16 hours employment in a relevant Early Years educational setting.
