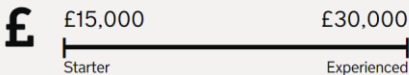

Cabin crew

Alternative titles for this job include flight attendant, air steward, air stewardess. Air cabin crew help make sure that airline passengers have a comfortable, safe and pleasant flight.

Average salary (a year)	Typical hours (a week)	You could work
	 30 to 40 a week	 evenings / weekends / bank holidays away from home

You can get into this job through:

- a college course
- an apprenticeship
- applying directly

College

You could do a college course like a Level 2 Certificate or Diploma in Air Cabin Crew, or study a cabin crew module as part of a broader travel and tourism course.

Entry requirements

You may need:

- 2 or more GCSEs at grades 9 to 3 (A* to D), or equivalent, for a level 2 course

Apprenticeship

You could start by doing a cabin crew advanced apprenticeship.

This will usually take 12 months to complete. You'll do on-the-job training and spend time with a college or training provider.

Entry requirements

You'll usually need:

- 5 GCSEs at grades 9 to 4 (A* to C), or equivalent, including English and maths, for an advanced apprenticeship

Direct Application

You could apply directly to [airlines](#) for a cabin crew job. Entry requirements vary but good customer service skills will be expected.

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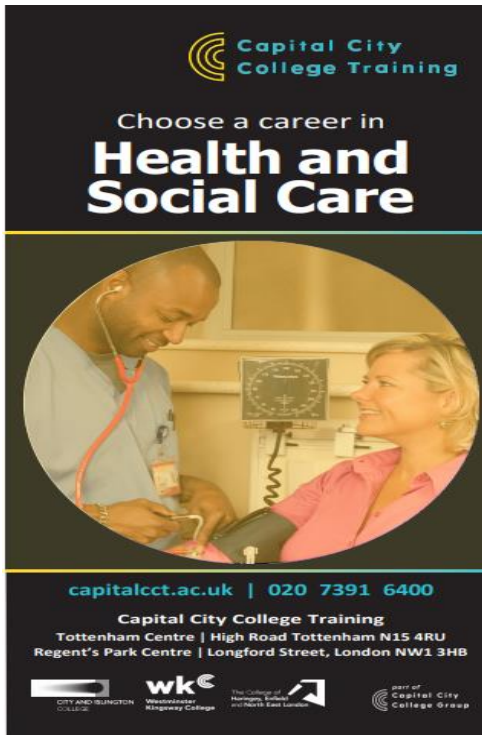
