


What is it?

Our **London Collection Bursary** has been introduced to support us in opening up roles related to collections in museums to people who may not have considered a career in the museum and heritage sector before now, including those who may have faced additional barriers throughout their time in education.

The bursary provides one student with the following:

- An annual £1000 bursary for the duration of their undergraduate studies
- A two-month paid summer placement working within one or more departments of the museum, for each year of their undergraduate studies.



Who is it for?

The bursary is intended to support a student who may be interested in a career in the museum and heritage sector but has had limited exposure to these sectors up to now.

Applications


We particularly welcome applications from the following groups, because we know they're underrepresented in the museum and heritage workforce:

- Applicants who identify as Black, Asian or ethnically diverse
- Disabled applicants
- Applicants who identify as male or non-binary



To be eligible you should:

- Have studied your post-16 qualifications in at a school or college in London
- Be planning to begin studying at a higher education institution in autumn 2024 (including if you're planning to apply through Clearing)
- Be intending to study a subject which you feel is relevant to the work of a museum
- Have an interest in learning more about working in museums



You might also have:

- Been eligible for free school meals (anytime during the last six years)
- Experience of care
