We are providing benefits advice and money support to residents across Camden. We want to support as many residents as possible to have the best chance to cope in this crisis and into the future.

Our support involves:

- Check if there are any benefits you could be receiving but are not yet getting
- Support you with a better-off calculation
- · Help you to make a benefit claim
- Support with benefit appeal/review
- · Advice if you have been overpaid on your benefits
- Check if you can receive a grant from the Cost-of-Living Fund
