## Have your say on the Sexual and Reproductive Health Strategy 2025-2030

Sexual and reproductive health is an important public health issue that has worsened in recent years. The boroughs have witnessed increases in sexually transmitted infections unplanned pregnancies and unequal access to reproductive services. Public health for Richmond and Wandsworth councils are therefore embarking on the development of new sexual and reproductive health strategies to reverse these trends.

The strategies will be informed by the respective 2024 Sexual and Reproductive Health Needs Assessments for <u>Richmond</u> and <u>Wandsworth</u> Councils. These are systematic and comprehensive evaluations of the current and future sexual and reproductive health needs of those who live, work, socialise or are educated in the boroughs. The assessments show that some groups have disproportionately poorer sexual and reproductive health outcomes and other groups are underserved.

Public health would therefore like to invite you to take part in our <u>public consultation</u> to help build an effective strategy that achieves our ambitious vision to maximise the impact of our resources and create a more equitable and accessible preventive and healthcare landscape for everyone.
