Support multi-partner funding bids for research, based on the city's healthcare priorities





## Leeds Academic Health Partnership: mission and vision




**Our vision** is that everyone in Leeds has the best opportunities to live a healthier life for longer.

   Leeds retains the fifth highest number of graduates in the UK.


### **Straightforward market access:**


