# **Business support for SMEs**



### **Leeds economy**

- 3<sup>rd</sup> largest city in the UK and regional capital of Yorkshire
- Economy worth £26.2 billion; GVA per head £34,510
- Significant draw for employment 471,000 employed in the city, net in commuting in excess of 100,000
- Low unemployment and high employment rates comparable with the England average
- 30,000+ businesses, 99.5% employing fewer than 250 staff
- Key sectors for private sector employment financial and business services, creative and digital, manufacturing, wholesale/distribution

#### **Key challenges**

- Like most cities in the UK has high levels of deprivation and relatively low wages in the inner city
- **Key issues post 2008** low economic growth, lack of business investment, low levels of productivity growth and investment in R&D, relatively low start up levels compared to England average
- Significant support for businesses during Covid Pandemic £300m provided in Leeds to keep businesses going in the form of Business Rate Relief and business grants

# BRC beginnings: launched 2011

- Provided repair service for military in London – Household Cavalry, Kings Troop & Royal Household Windsor
- September 2016, extended to Tri-Service, covering Scotland, North, South East and London, processing 5,000 pairs annually



# Sustainability (2020)

- Launched ReVivo for VivoBarefoot
- The first footwear company to offer pre-owned graded shoes
- Huge success of sales in 2023, selling 75,000 pairs and becoming a £6m business.
- 2024 projected 100,000 pairs
- New customers since ReVivo launch: Birkenstock, Dr Martens, Dubarry, Fairfax & Favor, Red Wings

## Scaling up

- New factory/warehouse in Hunslet, 12,000 sqft
- Bespoke software system to manage entire repair process
- Flexible working hours, partnered with local schools
- Investment in machinery and training to take on the work
- Dr Martens bespoke machinery, factory training and in-house coaching
- Level 2 Footwear

   Apprenticeship
