01 GET STARTED WITH RADIO IN PARTNERSHIP REFORM RADIO



Are you aged 16-30 and interested in a career in Radio? Reform Radio are working in partnership with The Prince's Trust to deliver a week-long virtual course with the aim of designing, developing and producing a radio show by the end of the week. We have a handful of FULLY FUNDED places for you to complete your Google IT Support Certificate. This is a Qualification, created by Google, to support you getting your foot in the door and hired for a number of great IT Roles. It is a

programme delivered online, and over a few short months you will be gain your qualification.

- Take part in exciting and fun tasks with the aim of preparing you for a radio show
- Work with a team of professional DJs and artists
- Meet new people, gain confidence, teamwork and communication skills
- Create podcasts throughout the week and create a pre-recorded show to be aired on the final day
- Gain a Bronze Arts Award Qualification
- Receive three months support post programme to help you move onto further training, education or employment.

03 GET INTO TECHNOLOGY WITH AMAZON WEB SERVICES AND GENERATION UK

The programme aims to take you from a beginner to an AWS Certified Cloud Support Practitioner in 12 Weeks, with guaranteed interviews with Cloud Employers in Manchester and a 6 month commitment to help you gain your first job in the industry. You will learn Python, Linux, SQL and AWS services alongside improving your employability skills in this 3

month FREE bootcamp. You must be aged 18-29 to apply and no experience is necessary; just a passion for a career in tech!

05 ENTERPRISE RELIEF FUND



A new funding initiative with NatWest to support self-employed young people struggling to keep their businesses afloat amid the coronavirus crisis. **please note due to high demand there is about a 4 week wait before you hear back, once you have applied for the grant**

To be eligible, young people must:

- Have started their businesses/become self-employed within the last four years
- Be aged 18-30 (young people over 30 who've started a business with support from The Trust will still be eligible, as long as they've been to business launch group in the last four years)

06 DEVELOPMENT AWARDS (FOR 16-30 YEAR OLDS)

We have introduced a few new options within the Development Awards that will support young people aged 16-30 year olds most in need during the current climate. Due to current demand the turnaround for processing a development award is at least 14 working days, but we will endeavour to keep you informed about the progress of your application.

Wi-Fi offer: pre-paid dongles to enable young people to access the internet for remote learning

Laptop / computing equipment offer: to support young people who are struggling to access courses currently enrolled on due to lack of equipment (please be aware there is limited availability on these resources)

Interim living expense offer: maximum £50 Supermarket Vouchers for those YP 16-25 on nil/low income due to the COVID-19 outbreak.

Interim transport offer: Free 28-Day bus passes for Care Leavers aged 18-21.

Grants for course fees, course equipment, travel costs, clothing for interviews and clothing for work, and other progression based activities which fall into our usual eligibility criteria detailed here: https://www.princestrust.org.uk/help-for-young-people/get-funding-train-learn
