Understanding Behaviour that Challenges



Challenging behaviour is causing increasing concern today, as many individuals have increasing levels of stress and uncertainty in their lives. This behaviour can be due to factors such as anxiety, neglect, abuse, learning disabilities and conditions like dementia. Understanding the causes of challenging behaviour is the first step towards finding ways to support individuals and manage their behaviour.

Principles of Business Administration



This qualification is designed to provide you with the underpinning knowledge to work in a range of different environments in a business administration role.

Business Improvement Techniques



Improving business performance is vital for any business. Working with Individuals with Learning Disabilities



As there are around 1.5 million people in the UK who have a learning disability and will find it difficult to describe their symptoms, it is essential for anyone working with individuals with a learning disability to have good knowledge of the healthcare system and legislation as well as an understanding of the signs and symptoms of various conditions. This nationally recognised Level 2 qualification provides an understanding of safeguarding and protection from abuse and the person-centered approach to risk-taking, alongside supporting individuals with learning disabilities.

Understanding Specific Learning Difficulties



Learning difficulties affect around 15% of people who find it harder to learn certain skills. It is important for those working in healthcare, social care and education to have knowledge of specific learning difficulties such as; ADHD, Dyslexia and Dyscalculia. This nationally recognised Level 2 qualification will provide you with the understanding of diagnosis, effects and context of specific learning difficulties and how to support individuals.





Working with People with Mental Health Needs



With an estimated 450 million people worldwide suffering from a form of mental health problem and many elements that are still not understood, it is essential for individuals working within a variety of care settings to have a good knowledge of mental health problems and how to support those displaying symptoms. This nationally recognised L2 qualification will help you to develop an understanding and appreciation of mental health problems and how this affects the individuals ability to cope and function and how you can provide the right support needed.





Understanding the Care and Management of Diabetes



In the UK alone 3.2 million people are diagnosed with Diabetes and a further 630.000 people unknowingly have the condition. The Principles of Dementia Care



With Dementia affecting around 820,000 people in the UK and the likelihood of this rising to one million by 2025, the understanding and the person-centered care that is required is fundamental in providing high quality care. This nationally recognised Level 2 qualification provides the knowledge and understanding of the various forms of Dementia and factors that can influence the communication and interaction of individuals. Furthermore, you will understand how to provide the appropriate care and support for engaging in activities, the importance of equality, diversity and inclusion and the administration of medication using a person-centered approach.

Understanding Dignity and Safeguarding in Adult Health and Social Care



A total of 103,900 safeguarding reports about vulnerable adults were referred in 2014/15. Care workers responsibilities in protecting the health, well-being and human rights of individuals are far-reaching and to allow individuals to live free from harm, abuse and neglect often involve health agencies, government departments or the police. This nationally recognised Level 2 qualification provides an understanding of the fundamentals of safeguarding, including; duty of care, understanding dilemmas and public concerns and dignity which are relevant to a wide range of care settings.

The Principles of End of Life Care



The number of people over the age of 64 in Britain is expected to rise from 9.5 million to 15 million by 2040. As the aging population grows, this means more people will live with serious chronic illness and need end of life care. The support needed is wide-ranging and a good understanding of pain management, support and quality of life is essential for all carers. This nationally recognised Level 2 qualification will provide an understanding of how to work within this setting, how to manage pain and discomfort along with understanding loss and grief in end of life care.

They can result in lack of confidence, isolation, fractures and broken bones. 


Managing your Money (NCFE Level 1 Award)
