School of Code have launched a free, 16-week, full-time, remote Skills Bootcamp in Software Development for individuals who aspire to start a new career in the tech. To be eligible, applicants need to be over 19 years old and reside within the North West region. Beginners are welcome to apply, you don't even to have seen a line of code before.

The course prides itself on being open to anyone, with cohorts reflecting the local population, a 50:50 gender split and an age-range of 18-60. We've helped former teachers, return to work parents, school leavers, refugees, the unemployed, barbers, retail assistants, musicians, artists, beauticians, personal trainers, PhDs, probation officers, health and hospitality workers all learn how to code and change their career paths. With an **85% employment rate** on completion of the course, our graduates have successfully secured tech roles at The Economist, Bravissimo, Santander, Gymshark, Purplebricks, Wise, and many more.
