



Are you based in the Greater Manchester area and currently unemployed, at risk of redundancy or considering returning to work after a break?

TRANSFORM is a government-funded programme, focused on supporting individuals to find rewarding careers in the Further Education (FE) sector. For those who do not see teaching, or working in another role in FE, as the right choice for them, they will be supported to look at other options, which could include alternative employment or further study/training.

TRANSFORM will provide you with a range of tailored support, depending on your individual need, which may include employability support, a short placement (2 to 3 days) in a Further Education setting, completion of a Level 3 Award in Education and Training (L3 AET) and completion of a range of CPD programmes such as Safeguarding, GDPR, etc.
