Introduction to Fruit and Veg Growing

Habitat Restoration and Tree Planting

Learn how to create and restore habitats and develop features for protected species. You will also learn about ecology, how to plant fruit trees and native trees and have a go at hands on habitat creation in local parks.

Green Roofs

Course 2: Oct 29th, Nov 6th, 13th, 20th

Learn how to construct a green roof and why green roofs are important. We will cover site/ structural considerations, drainage, planting, and maintenance/ aftercare. You will get the opportunity to build a small-scale green roof that you can replicate at home, and there will be a visit to see green roofs in Manchester city centre.

Hydroponics and Microgreens

Hydroponics means growing plants without soil. The course covers equipment and material needed, plants, and nutrients. Find out how hydroponics has the potential for growing food in cities. Have a go at growing microgreens too and learn how to build a DIY hydroponics system in our Boiler House workshop.
