Apprenticeships

Our programme of trade apprenticeships at WCHG has been designed to create a work-based learning model. It allows you to train on the job under supervision whilst attending college one day a week to gain a trade qualification. We offer an apprenticeship that not only provides a qualification but provides work experience in a real environment, learning vital skills for a successful career.

Over the last 12 months we have recruited six apprentice's across various trades including **Plastering**, **Plumbing** and **Business Admin**. And we currently have **25** Apprentices within the business, across various departments and trades and our recruitment will continue towards the middle of the year!

Our aim is to upskill the residents of **M22 and M23** and our apprenticeships are open to everyone over 16 years old and who lives in these postal areas. There is no upper age limit and we encourage applications from all genders and backgrounds to represent the wider community.

What makes us different?

We pay the **Real Living Wage** to all our employees and that includes our apprentices.

Recruitment usually takes place during the summer months but keep your eyes on our website from spring when we start to promote recruitment.
