Eligibility Criteria

- Unemployed and not currently working or studying
- Looking for full-time work and available for all shift patterns, including evenings, weekends and bank holidays
- Right to work in the UK without sponsorship
- Eligible for GMCA Adult Education Funding
- Qualification requirements for lab assistant role
- Priority given to Manchester and Trafford residents
- You must be 18+

What's involved?

Apprenticeship-First Roles

We are recruiting for roles on an apprenticeship-first basis. This means:

- Once eligibility criteria has been assessed, successful candidates will be expected to enrol onto our Level 2 Apprenticeship Programme
- Full criteria will be discussed and assessed during the recruitment process
- Enrolment is required if you are successful and offered a place on the programme

Placements will be spread across all of our main sites which include North Manchester General Hospital, Oxford Road Campus (MRI) and Wythenshawe Hospital

Available Roles:

Trainee Nursing Assistant

Want to work with patients? This is a key role working alongside our nursing team to support patient care and will include assisting patients with mobility, feeding, washing, dressing, toileting and personal care.

Complex Care (Community – Children's Services)

Working in the community:

- Supporting children and their families in their own homes (overnight care)
- Providing a higher level of support for children with complex needs
- Examples of care may include supporting children who are:
 - Using breathing machines
 - Receiving feeding support via specialist equipment

This role requires compassion, responsibility, citywide working and a willingness to learn advanced care skills.
