  - At risk of redundancy
  - Working part-time but would like to work more
  - Employment affected by COVID-19



### WHAT WILL THE PROGRAMME COVER?

Those taking part will be allocated a careers coach to provide support one-to-one through the entire programme. We will also work with other projects across Milton Keynes to help people get all the support they need to get back to work.
