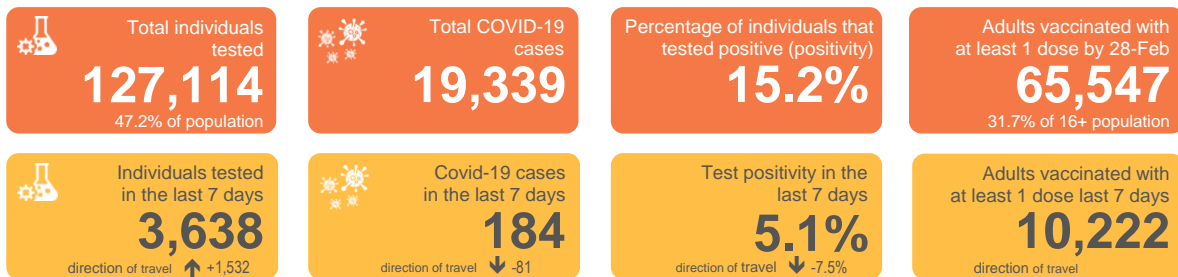

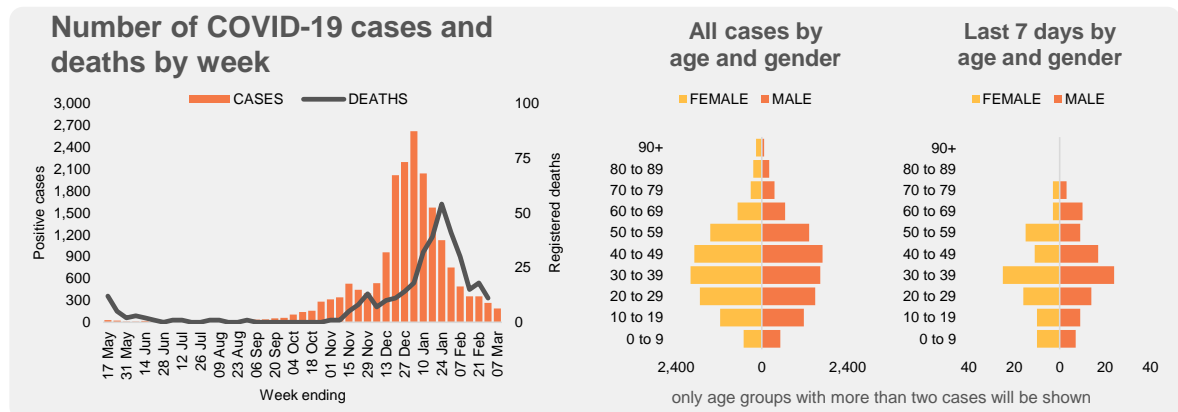

Direction of travel compares current snapshot against previous snapshot

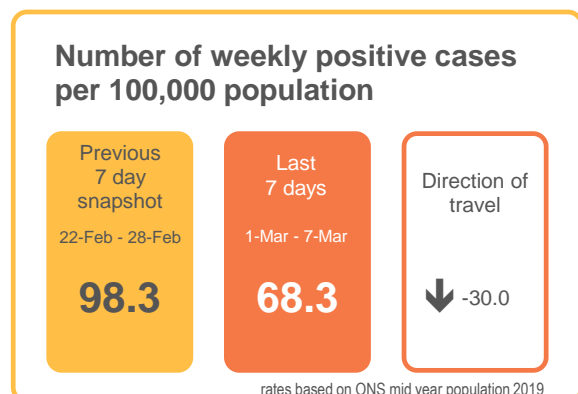
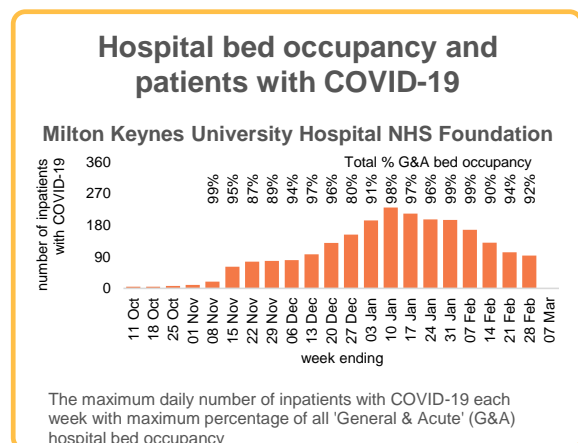
