

## Early Years

- 274 EY settings open to all children, including school based nurseries
- 4,790 children attending (up from 3,957 on 4 March)
  - 201 are classed as vulnerable
  - 53 have a social worker
  - 16 have an EHCP
- No sufficiency issues have been identified
- 1 EY settings closed, not for Covid related reasons (1 childminders)

## Confirmed Covid cases in Schools and EY settings

- MK rates continue to drop but remain higher than regional and national, see graph below  
Following the reopening of schools on 8 March there are currently
- 20 children who reported a positive test (up from 6 children)
- 6 staff who have reported a positive test (down from 9 staff)
- 12 settings with positive cases (down from 14 settings)
  - 11 schools
  - 1 EY settings

## Schools

- All schools reopened on 8 March with secondary schools operating a phased return.
- Number of students impacted by “bubble” closures: School A (30) School B (17) School C (38) School D (33)
- All children will be able to access remote learning if they are not eligible to receive face to face education
- Attendance data was available from 96 out of 111 schools on the DfE portal on 11 March, see below:
