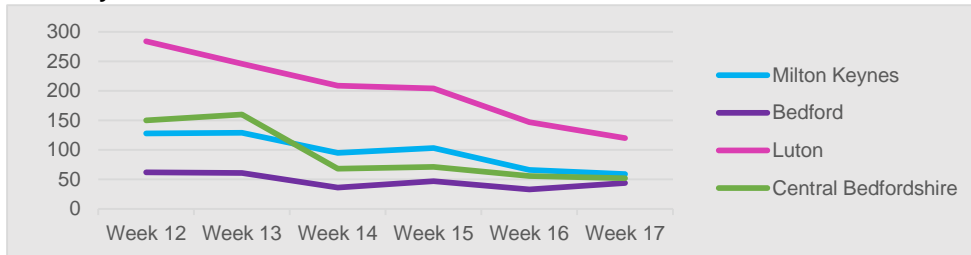

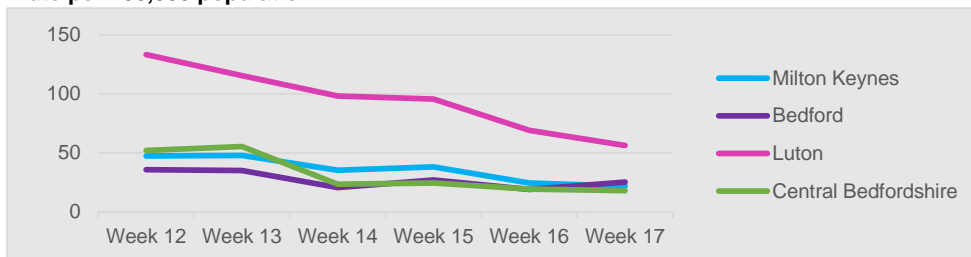

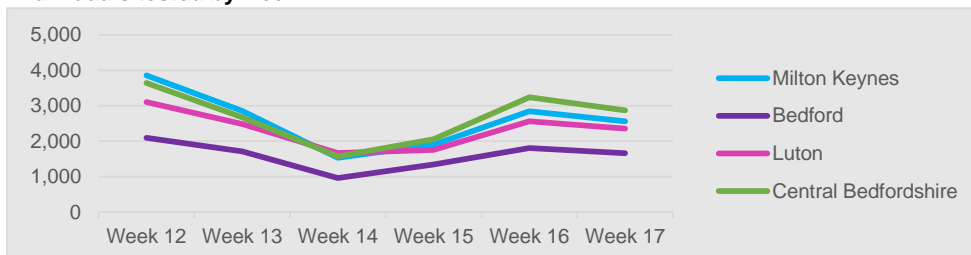
Cases by week
