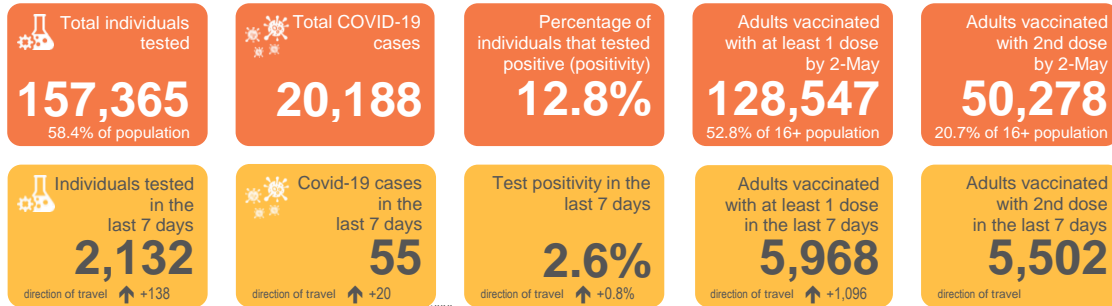

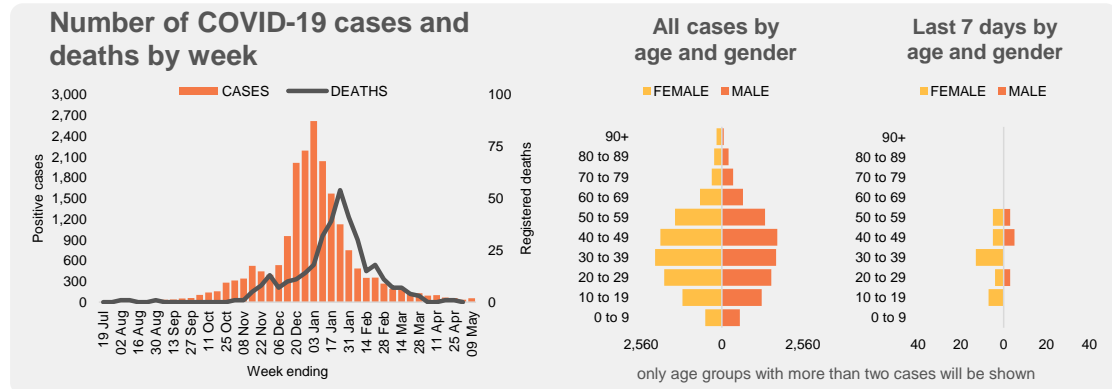

Direction of travel compares current snapshot against previous snapshot

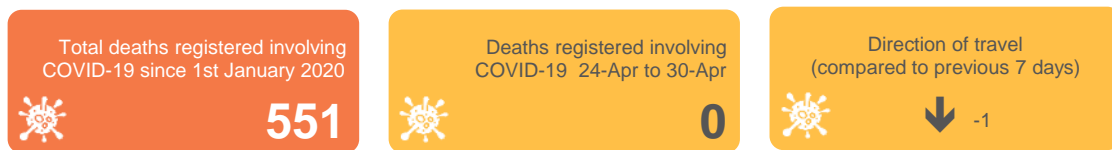
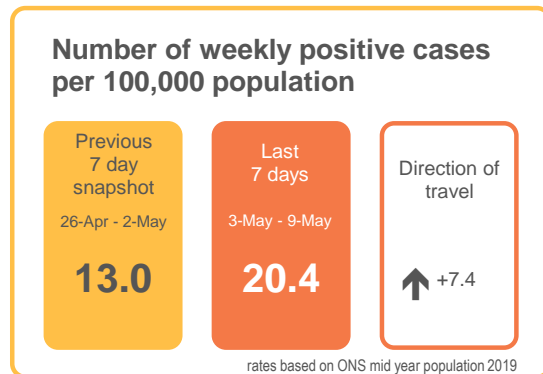
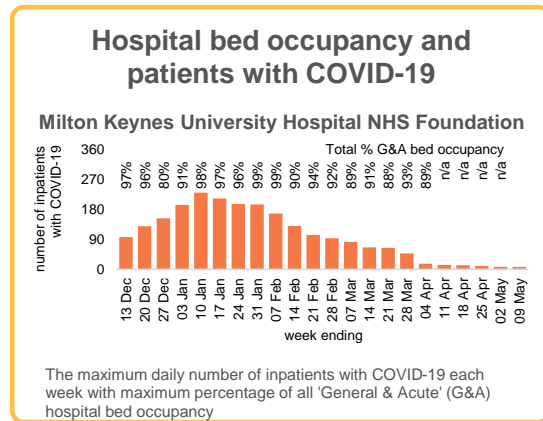

Please note: numbers in recent days may rise, reflecting diagnostic and reporting turnaround time. All detail within this report is the latest data available prior to publishing (12/05/2021).

Week-to-week comparisons are based on the data available at the time each snapshot was published.

On 9 April there was a change to case reporting in England. Cases that have been identified through a positive rapid lateral flow test are now removed for people who took Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) tests within 3 days that were all negative. This resulted in the removal of 31 cases for Milton Keynes.
