Panther – Golden - 3.7% - Reepham Light & refreshing with American hops for a citrus hit with a gentle floral aroma.	
Brewsters – Marquis – 3.8% - Grantham Tawny, refreshing English session bitter with maltiness and a dry finish.	
Parkway – Talking Parrot – 3.8% - Somerton, Somerset Session bitter from this new brewery. Sure to have you oohing and arring – in a good way ☺	
Pitchfork – PG Steam – 4.0% - Weston-Super-Mare Golden multi layered ale with floral hop aromas and a medium bodied hoppy, bitter taste with some fruit and sweetness.	
Blimey – Son of Paleface – 4.0% - Norwich Well-hopped pale-ale from this new Norwich brewery, which is causing a lot of excitement in certain quarters.	
Humpty Dumpty – Swallowtail - 4.0% - Reedham Light & refeshing golden ale with a lively hop finish. The taste of summer, but with enough of an edge to have a little bite.	
Crouch Vale – Nelson Sauvin – 4.1% - South Woodham Ferrers Explosively hoppy pale ale. Think about something explosive, but add a little more punch, New Zealand hops style.	
Charles Wells & XT Brewing Co -Wild – 4.2% - Bedford. Punchy American style IPA infused with chinook, cascade & columbus hops giving a clean refreshing finish. Boom!	
Elland – Nettle Thrasher – 4.4% - Elland, West Yorks Copper coloured, complex and fruity. Made from a combination of six malts, with English challenger & bramling cross hops.	
Cotleigh – Styrian Wolf – 4.4% - Wiveliscombe, Somerset Bright golden beer brewed with Styrian wolf hops. Hints of mango, lemongrass & passionfruit. (Yes, really – try it!)	
Upham – Winter's T'Ale – 4.5% - Upham, Hampshire	Smooth on the palate with an initial sweet surge, echoes of toffee and citrus fruits followed by a distinctive bitter-sweet malty finish. Will this sell out first? We think it might...
Winter's – Citra Sunset – 4.5% - Norwich New beer from Winter's. Light-amber coloured. Distinctive, and a bit of a departure for the brewery, in a very good way.	
Panther – Winter Porter – 5.0% - Reepham Full flavoured, slightly smokey porter with a smooth bittersweet character. A proper porter, and as tasty as they come.	
Green Jack – Baltic Trader – 10.5% - Oulton Broad. Export stout. A real heavyweight brewed with molasses and three roasted malts. At a whopping 10.5% this isn't to be taken lightly, but is absolutely packed with flavour.
