- Training for PVI setting staff, school EYFS staff, childminders, SENCOs and managers
- This course includes: legislation, key responsibilities, early identification, implementing the Graduated Approach and effective parent partnerships.
- A 2- hour recorded webcast including supportive documents and web links freely available on the nasen website from the end of this month
- Last year 95% of the 782 people who attended the training face to face reported that their understanding of SEND had increased.











The EY SEND Review Guide

- Developed by AfA and nasen via DfE funding
- Forms the framework for a self or peer review
- Enables settings to understand what is required for a whole setting approach and consider next development points



- 30 min webcast, 2.5 hour webinar and supporting documents
- Last year 416 SENCOs, managers and LA staff attended the training face to face and 100% positive feedback.

- Not designed to be a monitoring tool- to be used collaboratively to support SENCOs and managers
- Freely available to download from nasen website but training recommended
- Process strengthened and improved with the strategic direction of the LA
