## **Support for Under 5s**

The Lead Professional for under 5s is either the Health Visitor or Family Nurse. They will provide parenting support directly.

Where there is no Lead Professional, all requests for parenting support, should be made via the Duty Health Visitor on 0300 123 6629.

## **Parenting Surgeries**

Parents who do **not** have a Lead Professional can access a parenting surgery. These are one off 30-minute- an hour sessions for those that need support around a specific issue or, general behavioural management support.

All requests for a parenting surgery should be emailed to the Parenting Service inbox ParentingService@portsmouthcc.gov.uk with the following information:

- Parent Name
- Contact Number and email address

- Focus Child Name and DOB
- Address
- · Summary on the areas of support needed.
- Availability for surgery

Sessions will be arranged to suit the parents.

Parents should contact the Parenting Service themselves to request a Parenting Surgery; where this is not possible, those supporting the family (e.g. SENCo, pastoral support etc.) should make it clear that the parents are fully aware and on-board with this request.

<u>Lead Professionals</u> who are working with a family should <u>not</u> refer to the surgeries but should request a TAW following the agreed process, booking **directly** with the practitioner via Outlook.

After you have sent in your referral to the Parenting inbox it will be passed along to the specialist's course team who will review if it is the most appropriate course for the family. Once they have reviewed the referral we will contact to say if the family have or have not been approved for the course and instruct on when they will receive an invitation or alternative options. Parents will receive a letter 3-4 weeks before the course is due to begin detailing how they book themselves on.
