## Overview

Everyone deserves the right to aspire to the very best future, yet nationally fewer than 5% of people with Special Educational Needs or Disabilities go on to secure full-time paid employment.

As practitioners we need to ensure that young people we support are inspired and confident to enter the world of employment. One tool that can be used to support young person is to create a vocational profile.

A vocational profile is a person-centred approach to finding out what a young person wants to do when they leave school or college. It provides an opportunity to understand what a person is interested in and to explore why. If we do not complete a vocational profile, then we do not know enough about a young person in relation to their aspirations for work and to get the best match of a job for them.
