

Hampshire and Wessex annual religious education conference 2024

Thursday 24 October 2024

This cross-phase conference is for primary, secondary and SEND RE teachers and leaders of RE.

The conference is to support teachers to teach RE well with *Living Difference IV*, the locally agreed syllabus for RE in Hampshire, Isle of Wight, Portsmouth and Southampton schools. Delegates will gain confidence in representing what it means to live with a religious orientation on life, in the classroom.

The day will include keynote sessions on raising the profile of RE and practical advice for creating effective learning environments in the classroom, invaluable for all teachers in every phase of education.

A diverse range of workshops will include choices such as: Cross-phase sessions on Pagan traditions, deep thinking in RE, and the Ofsted Subject report, along with phase specific sessions such as knowledge and remembering in primary RE, Islam in primary RE, exam board input and assessment in KS3.

Teachers attending the conference will:

- Gain knowledge of the requirements to teach RE from the law and Ofsted
- gain confidence to teach RE well in their school
- gain confidence in the subject knowledge required to teach RE well
- gain confidence in making curriculum with Living Difference IV to ensure all children
