Want to make a significant difference to pupils' life chances by choosing a literacy intervention that positively impacts confidence and self-esteem, language, communication, phonics reading and writing?

National Literacy Trust survey shows lowest levels of reading enjoyment in a generation. ¹

30% of five-year-olds in England are falling behind expected reading levels. They are also behind in communication and language skills. Phonics programmes alone will not meet their needs.

The education system in England is currently failing the most disadvantaged and vulnerable children and young people. They are, on average, one year behind by the time they leave primary school. ²

In the most disadvantaged areas of England, more than a quarter of children have low literacy levels for their age (National Literacy Trust)

Reading will be key for many pupils in the enhancement of the recovery curriculum and the reengagement to school life and learning.
