Additionally, they will discuss how, as part of their National Priority Project (NPP), they are working hard to reduce barriers to language learning for more vulnerable learners through the medium of song.

Finally, they will share some of the task-based resources which enhance motivation and support preparation for the GCSE Speaking examinations.
