

























ROTHERHAM COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS GUIDE

Rotherham is now following COVID Alert Level – NATIONAL LOCKDOWN restrictions which include:

<p>Social and family gatherings (home or garden)</p> <p>Do not meet with people from outside your household or support bubble in your home or garden.</p> 	<p>Pubs, restaurants and cafés</p> <p>Closed but food and drink permitted to be taken away. Between 10pm and 5am food and drink must be pre-ordered. Takeaway of alcohol to be pre-ordered at all times.</p> 	<p>Travel and holidays</p> <p>No overnight stays away from home. Travel in UK or abroad only for work, education or other permitted reason.</p> 	<p>Long-term residential care venues</p> <p>Check with the care provider. Restrictions may apply.</p> 	<p>Essential retail and services (supermarkets, pharmacies, garages, banks, vets and takeaways)</p> <p>Open but COVID-19 safety measures in place. Face coverings must be worn indoors.</p> 
<p>Social and family gatherings (outdoor public places)</p> <p>You can meet in a public outdoor space with your household, support/childcare bubble, or one other person.</p> 	<p>Leisure centres, gyms and pools</p> <p>Not permitted to operate. Except for school activities.</p> 	<p>Hotels, hostels and guesthouses</p> <p>Only open for specific purposes, e.g. essential work travel, to support the homeless.</p> 	<p>Over 70s and medically vulnerable</p> <p>Clinically vulnerable people will be advised by their doctor if they need to shield.</p> 	<p>Schools and Adult/Higher Education</p> <p>Open. COVID-19 plans in place.</p> 
<p>Non-essential retail and close contact services</p> <p>Not permitted to operate. Includes clothing stores, hairdressers and salon, and tattoo parlours.</p> 	<p>Religious venues</p> <p>Open only for independent prayer, funerals and broadcasting services.</p> 	<p>Informal childcare with family or friends (under 14s)</p> <p>Those in childcare bubble can look after children but no mixing allowed outside of childcare bubble.</p> 	<p>Funerals</p> <p>Maximum of 30 mourners. Cemeteries remain open but no household mixing allowed.</p> 	<p>Childcare settings (including childminders, after-school clubs and nannies)</p> <p>COVID-19 measures in place. Continue to use.</p> 
<p>Bars and entertainment venues</p> <p>Temporarily closed. Includes: bars, cinemas, casinos and betting shops.</p> 	<p>Weddings</p> <p>Not permitted to take place.</p> 	<p>Childcare (separated parents)</p> <p>Childcare between separated parents can continue as normal.</p> 	<p>Workplace</p> <p>Work from home where possible.</p> 	<p>Work inside homes (for Council or repair services)</p> <p>Permitted with COVID-19 safety measures in place. Includes cleaners, social care, construction and Council repair work.</p> 
<p>Indoor cultural venues</p> <p>Temporarily closed. Includes: museums, theatres, children's soft play centres, ice skating rinks, zoos, theme parks and fairgrounds.</p> 	<p>Public transport</p> <p>Face coverings must be worn. Where possible cycle or walk.</p> 	<p>Hospital visits</p> <p>Check with the hospital. Restrictions may apply – close family and friends only.</p> 	<p>Sporting Events</p> <p>No spectating for professional or semi-professional sports. Sports clubs and classes must not run.</p> 	<p>Enforced restrictions in place</p> <p>Limitations/restrictions in place</p> <p>Some changes in operation apply</p>
