

Sandwell Family Hubs

Family Hubs provide specialised free programmes for parents/carers, such as Stepping Stones and Cygnet, alongside Parent/Carer Drop-ins for support, advice, and signposting to wider services. We also host various inclusive free sessions for children and families, including smaller, calmer Relaxed Stay and Play sessions, and specialist groups like the Sandwell Deaf Community Association Stay & Play. Furthermore, you will find the Local Authority Sensory Support Team delivering targeted sessions within the hubs for children with sight or hearing loss.

A key focus for our Family Hubs is early identification and intervention. We support this through [Wellcomm Screening](#), a language development screening offered to all children at 18 months. If needs are identified, your child will be invited to attend our specialist Communication/Language Sessions, developed with the Speech & Language team. Our team will also create a Watchful Eye to monitor development and facilitate access to specialist services. We maintain strong partnerships with key agencies like Early Years Inclusive Learning Services, Speech and Language Therapy, CAMHS, and SENDIASS, and we can connect you with vital local partners such as Autism West Midlands, Sandwell Parents for Disabled Children, and Sandwell Parents Voice United (SPVU).
