In the event of disruption to waste collections

If we are unable to collect your waste – e.g. due to severe bad weather, please:

- · Leave your refuse bin out. If we can't get to you on your scheduled collection day, we'll come back and collect it as soon as we can when it is safe to do so.
- Take your garden waste bin back in and put it out on your next scheduled garden waste collection day.
- · Leave your recycling boxes and blue bags out (as long as they don't present a trip hazard). We'll collect them as soon as we can when it is safe to do so.
