

Keep Shropshire Warm is an energy advice partnership between Marches Energy Agency (MEA) and Shropshire Council. We accept referrals on behalf of residents from friends, family, and professionals - or residents can contact us directly. Advice is given over the phone by trained energy advisors. For those who need it, there is the option of a follow up home visit or ongoing casework support.

The Keep Shropshire Warm team can provide advice in relation to:

- Keeping warm at home
- Financial support and discounts
- Energy bills, tariffs & suppliers
- Support during power cuts
- General energy use/behaviour
- Energy efficiency grants for heating & insulation
- Retrofitting energy measures (see notes below)

Sustainable Warmth Shropshire - Energy efficiency grants available to help with heating, insulation and improving the energy efficiency of homes. Eligibility criteria apply - the Keep Shropshire Warm team can advise or residents can apply online directly here: https://www.shropshire.gov.uk/keep-shropshire-warm

- Loft, cavity and solid wall insulation
- Park home insulation
- Floor and roof insulation
- Air source heat pumps, as first-time central heating or to replace old or broken LPG, oil or solid fuel heating systems
- Modern high heat retention electric storage heating
- First-time double glazing and external door upgrades
- Solar PV panels and battery storage technology

Priority Services Register - we can register vulnerable householders so that they are prioritised in the event of a power cut.

Warm Home Discount applications - eligible residents may be able to obtain a £140 energy bill discount.

Benefits checks referrals to Age UK and Citizens Advice, to help residents access the support they're entitled to.

Fuel Debt Fund - we can access funding for householders worried about energy debt. This can be used to clear part or all of the debt to provide a fresh start. We also work with householders to help them avoid accruing debts in future. Referral link can be found here.

Pre-Payment Meter Vouchers - we have a limited number of pre-payment vouchers that can be issued to residents who have a pre-payment meter and are at risk of self-disconnection.

Health and cold homes – Healthy Homes Shropshire provides in-depth support to those struggling with a cold home and health conditions or other vulnerabilities. In addition to our usual suite of support, we can now also help with flexible crisis support including small grants.

Retrofitting energy measures – we have a pilot project looking at how to upscale the retrofitting of energy measures to existing properties in the Marches. This will include providing a fully-funded Energy Efficiency survey for your home.
