As part of the Asthma bundle of care, it is a requirement that Asthma networks should develop health education strategies for their local population to allow them to raise awareness when a child or young person may have asthma and signpost to the relevant healthcare professional.

We acknowledge schools will have a "Supporting pupils at school with medical conditions" policy as set out in the statutory guidance; to enhance this further the Shropshire Telford and Wrekin Children and Young Peoples Asthma Clinical Network have produced Asthma School Advisory Policy Guidance document to provide guidance to schools to enable them to support children and young people with asthma.
