# **Notification of Statutory Safeguarding Audit Process 2025-2026**

I am writing to inform you that, as part of Shropshire Council's statutory responsibility to safeguard and promote the welfare of all children and young people in our area, we will shortly be inviting you to complete the annual statutory safeguarding audit for your setting for this academic year.

All registered education providers in Shropshire will be required to submit their audit using an online platform to ensure that all providers are compliant with their legal safeguarding duties and local safeguarding arrangements. This process replaces the previous "Section 11 audit" and templates.

## **Audit Timeline**

## Audit Opens 8th December 2025:

### Please note:

- Ensure the above email address is whitelisted
- The link in the invitation email is for you only and is not to be forwarded to anyone else. You can assign other people in your organisation to complete/access the audit once you have logged in (instructions on how to do this will be provided).

## Audit Closes 27th March 2026:

You have the duration of the Spring Term to complete the audit.

The Education Quality Safeguarding Team will be providing support to help providers complete the audit. This will include:

### Summer Term 2026:

The Education Quality Safeguarding Team will provide indicative findings to the Education Partnership and Children's Safeguarding Partnership Boards, will review audit completion and follow the non-completion escalation process (included in the email with this letter).

Audits will be reopened in the week commencing 4<sup>th</sup> May 2026 for agreed extensions (by exception only) and ongoing updates.

#### Autumn Term 2026:

The Education Quality Safeguarding Team will report thematic findings from the audits to the Education Partnership and Children's Safeguarding Partnership Boards. Preparations will begin for the 2026-2027 audit, which will be launched again in the Spring Term.
