BEHAVIOUR SUPPORT

We offer behavioural and SEMH support from expertly skilled professionals with experience of specialist behavioural, and specialist SEMH provisions.



SPECIALIST ADVICE

We provide specialist advice from highly qualified advisory teachers with expertise across the four broad areas of need.



CONSULTANCY

We deliver consultancy services for school improvement with a SEND and Inclusive Provision lens, focusing on reducing exclusion and improving attendance.

SUPPORT AVAILABLE

We offer four distinct tiers of support to meet the diverse needs of children and young people (CYP), reflecting a graduated approach. Following feedback from services users in 2024/25, we have expanded our offer. All prices are inclusive of travel. Schools are welcome to buy as they need and mix and match between tiers - there is no minimum purchase required. There is also the option to buy multiple amounts to form a 'package'.

Our Service operates on a term time basis and our capacity runs from September to July of each Academic Year.

BEHAVIOUR AND SEMH SUPPORT TIER (BST)

Our BST tier focuses on providing targeted behaviour and SEMH support. This tier does not use diagnostic screeners but can be used by schools to seek advice and guidance on SEMH needs and be signposted without requiring a full assessment.
