1 Online Safety Workshops

Richard delivers about 10 sessions per term for students, staff, governors and families, covering online safety in line with KCSIE guidance.

2 Staff & Governor Online Safety Training

Specialist training supported by free resources including the 2026 KCSIE poster. This is now linked to the DfE Policy paper Generative artificial intelligence (AI) in education.

3 Computing & Robotics In-School Workshops

Richard has supported over 100 schools with in-class sessions and workshops that include the use of green screen, robotics, AI literacy, coding, 3D modelling and data logging.

4 CPD in AI

Richard has delivered 8 CPD courses in AI focussing on ensuring effective teaching, GDPR compliance, AI literacy and an awareness of bias within AI models.

5 Computing Coordinator Updates

Termly meetings are organised for your computing lead. These cover policy writing, curriculum changes, progression and new resources. These are run by Richard with guest speakers to ensure national coverage.

6 Initial Teacher Training (ITT) Support

Richard works with three ITT providers within Telford and Shropshire to ensure trainee teachers have first-class knowledge of both computing and online safety.

7 Effective use of technology for SEND

Richard is the External Consultant for Shropshire Council Assistive Technology Library. He runs courses and works in schools to integrate technology into classrooms to support SEND learners.
