We know that the cost of living crisis means that times can be challenging right now for families.

For the Easter holidays we have put together a package of support that offers ways for families to stay healthy and happy over the holidays.

Food vouchers

Families with children who receive income-related free school meals and pre-school benefits, as well as care leavers, may be eligible for extra food vouchers.

The food vouchers have already been issued in February, so you will have already received them if you are eligible.

The vouchers are **worth £15 per child** for each week of the Easter holidays, and can be used at local supermarkets.

Happy Healthy Active Holidays returns

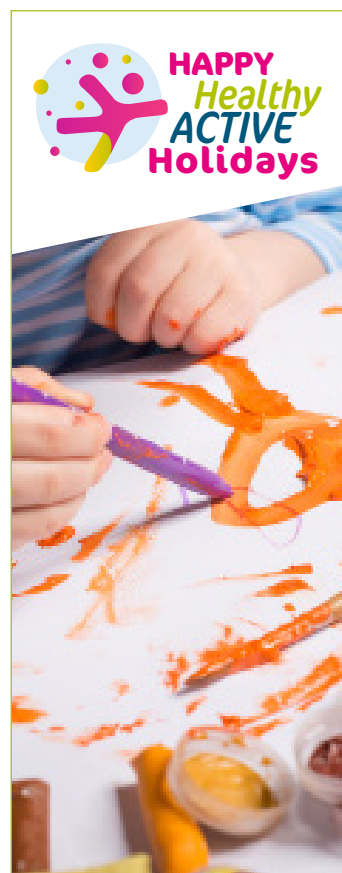
