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New Ofsted Guidance and Training to Support You

New Ofsted guidance that will be used from September 2019 has recently been published. Details of which can be found [here](#).

The Education Inspection Framework sets out how Ofsted will inspect all education establishments including registered early years settings in England.

The Early Years Inspection Handbook is primarily a guide for Ofsted Inspectors on how to carry out inspections.

Ofsted have also published the guidance on their website so that childcare providers are aware of Ofsted's inspection processes and procedures under the Education Inspection Framework (EIF.)

We have scheduled two targeted workshops to ensure all Settings are ready for the changes to the Ofsted Framework from September 2019:

- Getting Ready for the New Ofsted Framework - for Childminders
- Getting Ready for the New Ofsted Framework - for Early Years Settings

These workshops are aimed at Childcare Practitioners to understand the new Ofsted Framework, the impact this will have on your practice and future Ofsted visits.

By the end of the session you will be able to;

- Identify key changes and the impact on practice
- Clarify what to expect from future inspections
- Discuss Ofsted criteria and judgements
- Plan for change

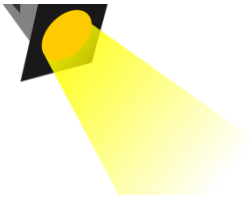
