Early Language Identification Measure and Intervention Training

Public Health England and the Department for Education's Best Start in Speech, Language and Communication Programme aims to improve the rate of early identification of need in the early years; and increase the number of children who are ready for school by the age of 5.

We will be delivering training sessions on the use of the new Early Language and Identification Measure (ELIM) and Intervention (to be offered alongside the ASQ-3 at the Healthy Child Programme 2—2½ year review).

Who should attend?

Leads/managers from health visiting, speech and language therapy, early years settings and those who will cascade locally.

Training Content:

- Background on the Best Start in Speech, Language and Communication programme
- How to use the ELIM and Intervention (incl. monitoring, and recording of data)
- Exploring how local areas and agencies can work collaboratively when using the ELIM and Intervention
