



## Lead Governor Training

These two-part courses are provided as part of the service level agreement (SLA) offer and have been very well received by governors. The training is designed to strengthen the role of the lead governor in the following priority areas:

- Safeguarding
- Disadvantaged children
- SEND & inclusion
- Curriculum

The objectives of the lead governor training programme are to:

- Improve outcomes for all learners in relation to the priority areas
- Improve the governing board's understanding of responsibilities and how to influence improvement
- Develop the role of the lead governor to support and enable the governing board

Initial analysis of feedback provided some clear themes in relation to the impact of the programme on governance practice. These included:

- Change in board culture, strengthening understanding that improvement in the priority is the responsibility of all
- Development of the lead governor role working in partnership with the chair
- Raised profile of the priority area throughout governing boards' monitoring
- Strengthening of governor monitoring practice enabling the board to have a better understanding of the priority area and drive improvement

Here is some feedback from lead governors that have completed the training:

*A clear presentation of the priority. A clear guide for the aspects of 'champion' through monitoring and impact.*

*Expert tutors who were very encouraging and clear.*

*The board is now aware of the school's ambition for all pupils with SEND and focused to find out from staff how this ambition is being met.*

*Governors now have greater understanding of their curriculum area and the wider curriculum.*

*The course has made me think about the way in which I communicate and involve the rest of the governing body in monitoring of the priority area.*
