- the name of your setting,
- why you would like to represent the Early Years providers in West Sussex, and
- what skills and experience you could bring to this role.

Election statements must be submitted by 18 October 2023.

If there is more than one candidate, a ballot will be arranged. Submitted election statements will be circulated with the ballot papers. All PVI Registered Providers meeting the requirements of the current Free Entitlement agreement will be eligible for election and to take part in this ballot. You will be unable to take part if you are:

- an elected member of the County Council who holds a Cabinet level post,
- a senior officer of the authority involved in strategic resource management, or
- a governor or other employee in West Sussex County Council settings including maintained nursery/primary/secondary/special schools.
