SUBJECT: Request for Exception to Policy to Army Regulation 190-13, paragraph 8-4.c. (3) – Gold Star and Next of Kin Survivor Family Member Unescorted Access

1. References:

2. The Office of the Provost Marshal General approves subject exception request. This exception accomplishes the following:

- a. Authorizes issuance of the Army Survivor Access Card to surviving parents (RA or RC Next of Kin) and surviving spouse and children (Next of Kin) of RC members who were not on a current order for a period not to exceed 36 months to receive Survivor Outreach Services long-term case management.

- b. Synchronizes the eligible population in AD 2021-21 with AR 190-13.

3. This exception will be incorporated into the upcoming AR 190-13 revision later this year.
