

New Census Bureau Population Estimates Pinpoint Cities in Nevada with Largest Population Gains

The U.S. Census Bureau reported today which incorporated cities in Nevada experienced the largest increases in population between July 1, 2014 and July 1, 2015.

The city gaining the most people in Nevada over the year was Las Vegas, whose population rose by 10,220 over the period. Las Vegas was followed by Henderson (8,365), Reno (4,370), North Las Vegas (4,099) and Sparks (1,370).

Nevada has a total of 19 incorporated cities. These incorporated cities do not include minor civil divisions, such as townships and precincts, nor census-designated places.

This information for cities is based on annual [population estimates](#) since the 2010 Census and up to July 1, 2015. Additional estimates are available for minor civil divisions in 20 states where these areas function as general-purpose governments. Also released today were July 1, 2015, estimates of the number of housing units for the nation, states and counties.
