

Despite COVID-19, the 2020 classing season was a success - read about our accomplishments below.

13,646,874 Upland bales and 531,974 Pima bales classed

> for a total of 14,178,848 bales, completing the classing of the 2020 cotton crop.

Kept all 10 classing offices operational throughout the season and delivered services within 2 days 90 percent of the time.

Our customers made over 265,000 connections to

retrieve nearly 50 million classing data records without any disruption.

Our Quality Assurance Division classed 28,300 samples submitted under Form D classification service, up nearly 10% from the previous season.

Our Market News Division delivered all reports 97.5 percent of the time with an accuracy rate of 99.26 percent, despite the challenges in collecting market information.





All Research and Promotion functions continued throughout the year with the Cotton Board, Cotton Incorporated, and USDA effectively conducting meetings and

communications virtually.

C&T's Standardization & Engineering Division shipped approximately 1,133 physical grade standards, 17,100 pounds of calibration cottons, 66.800 pounds of evaluation cottons. and 179 color calibration tile sets (March 2020-March 2021) for the grading and marketing of

cotton domestically and internationally.
