Notes: There is a difference between high tunnels and greenhouses. High tunnels are seasonal, semi-permanent structures that are not heated and have very few amenities. They are a framed structure with a plastic covering that is manually ventilated. Greenhouses are permanent year-round structures and can include amenities such as on-site electricity, automated ventilation/circulation, and insulation/external heat. They are typically much more expensive per square foot than high tunnels. We are offering high tunnel and greenhouse information due to some overlap in design considerations and agricultural practices.

Fence Emporium of Alaska, another Alaska high tunnel source, changed ownership in 2022 and no longer fabricates high tunnel structures.
